The numbers convert in reverse to give further instructions. Quite a few competitors found it impossible to plot a route avoiding the GA (gradient arrow) in GS8443, but it was possible - in fact there were two possibilities either via the A36(T) (shorter) or via Warminster Common (longer). Some also ignored the instruction to avoid roads with letters overprinted (but numbers were acceptable of course!).

## WIN IN THE WOODS FOR BOOTHER

The latest round in the Championship has been won by John Boother from near Reading. A 3 second advantage on the LANGER PARK saw the honours go to Berkshire, with Ted Manktelow from Rickmansworth runner-up. Roger Lintott from Hampshire completed the top three, 55 seconds off the pace, but this result was sufficient to give him a 5 point lead in the Championship going into the final round. Phil Bird and Stuart Martingale rounded off the top five finishers.

The Eastern Counties' event generated 132 entries and boasted a magnificent 72% (95) maps returned for marking. The vast majority of competitors seemed extremely happy with the routecards on offer judging by the comments sent to the organisers.

The conclusion of the LANGER PARK enables the table alongside to be produced. Competitors gaining a result from three events have had their highest score ignored to arrive at the 'counting total'.
