RESULTS

With the introduction of the National TT Championship resulting in a mailing list of over 500 people, who could be championship contenders, the potential size of the entry to the Nelly gave us nightmares! As we also run a Minor Competition, drawing in about 150 on average, the thought of a 600+ was a prospect not to be relished! We decided to send Regs to all our last year's entrants, those that specifically wrote for the Regs (from the Championship initial publicity), those that requested Regs from our normal publicity outlets, and, finally, a random number from the Championship mailing list. We think we got the mix right as only one person has since contacted us to say that he missed the Nelly!

We ended up with 278 entries for the Full and 138 in the Minor. With a total entry just over the 400, a third up on last year, it has proved just about right - the Organisation has not been strained in any way!

With 45 'Unattached' and 57 'CSMA Unattached' entries in the Full we felt that some tangible form of appreciation should be shown! Eight engraved pens, four for each section, are extra awards for the 'Four best' not having won any other award - hope you like them. An extra pen has been added to the Minor Section award list as we had 84 'Unattached CSMA members' - a record! One extra, unannounced award, goes to Keith Cunningham of Northern Ireland who was the first person to send in an answer sheet! A free entry for NN '88 is the prize!

Congratulations to all the winners. These results, plus the prizes, should reach you before Christmas and it is hoped that this 'puts the icing on the cake' - at least for some of you!

As NN '87 comes to an end plans for NN '88 are already in hand! Regulations will be available, and sent automatically to all this year's entrants, early in September with a closing date of 13th October. The competition will run from 20th October to 15th November. You can put these dates into your new diary straight away.

For CSMA members looking for something to do end Feb, beginning March why not have a go at the Cultivator TT Rally? Closing date for entries is 10th February. If you miss the entry form in the M&L drop a note to Bob Thomas, 84, The Josselyns, Trimley St Mary, Ipswich, IP10 OXW. With two classes at a cost of £2.75 it is good value. Run by Ipswich Group it has, over the years, been of very good standard.

In conclusion - those of you new to Nelly must wonder how we can give such a long list of awards - £212-50 in cash alone!
