Thank you all for entering the Nelly National '92 - be it the FULL, the qualifying event for the National Championship, or the MINOR, which attracts newcomers to the fascination of map reading and a faithful following of 'Regulars' who enter for the fun of it!

We had 134 entries for the FULL, down from 161 in '91 (sign of the times?) but the MINOR attracted 160 compared with last year's 141! What is most encouraging from the Organisers point of view is that the percentage of returned answer sheets in both sections has shown a slight increase to 67% in the FULL and 51% in the MINOR. This apparent low return in the MINOR is not as bad as it might seem! Almost a half of the MINOR entry came from our publicity in M&L, our National Club magazine, and really haven't the experience, or know how, for such a type of event! However it is hoped that now that the full answers are given, with how each section was traversed, a little time is spared to take on board the knowledge and, hopefully, will encourage a further attempt next year!

After several near misses, he was 3rd last year, Mike Biss has taken the FULL - most deservedly. That he happens to be a member of the Organising Group is neither here nor there as, believe us, he is a formidable competitor in anything he does! Tony Preston, who won the MINOR last year, was Runner-up this time so the pace could be quite something next year! Third man, Pete James, was 5th last year whilst Stuart Martingale - a new name to us - came 4th and took the Best Non-CSMA award. Terry Croucher, Swindon Group, took the Best CSMA and Best Lady spot went to Gillian Goodlass who progressed from 20th overall last year to 17th this time! With 44 CSMA Unattached to Groups entries in the FULL such support cannot go unrecognised so 3 additional engraved pens have been awarded! R. Sanders (CSMA Unattached), D. Collins (Devizes) and D. Watts (NatWest Bank) collected £45 between them for the 'Best not in Top 10' for the past three years - just reward for continuity in support for the Nelly! With the first 21 all collecting awards in some shape or form we feel that we have given excellent rewards for the efforts made.

In the MINOR - Cath Woodman (CSMA North West London Group) was the Overall Winner. She is a regular 'on the road competitor' and the Course on Rally Navigation will be much appreciated. John Owen and Phillip Copping (both CSMA Unattached) took the next two spots and, no doubt, will be trying their hand in the FULL next year? With 20 entries coming from Unattached to Clubs supporters and 123 coming from CSMA Unattached to Groups the Organisers have given each section three additional prizes by way of appreciation. These awards are in the form of Jersey First Day Covers of their Vintage Cars Series of Stamps. We managed to get the President of the Jersey Old MC to sign them so they are unique. There MAY be an article in M&L (the CSMA House Mag) in due course - keep your eyes open! Ruth Brooks was the Best Lady and, nice to report, the third best Lady was Jenny Moulton at the age of 13! Nice to see the youngsters getting involved.

As usual our grateful thanks to our Sponsors - Frizzell Financial Services Ltd, Britannia Rescue, Ordnance Survey and Rally Navigation Services for their support and donations which enables us to give such a valuable and extensive awards list - the best in the business!

Nelly National '93 will run during similar dates - avoiding the RAC - so keep the dates free. Map 126 A3 Edition will be used and, as usual, the Regs will be sent to you all early in September. Meantime - take care - have a Very Merry Christmas (off the road!) and all the best for the New Year.
