Don Clarke, 20th last year, came third just pipping Tony Preston - who won the Minor in '91 and was Runner-up last year! Anne Wilson, 19th last year, improved to 15th this year and thereby took 'Best Lady'. Consistant support from CSMA members - unattached to any Group - has again been recognized. There were 42 so the first three - Mike Keeble, David Enticott & Godfrey Nunn - have collected engraved pens!

Colin Hensman has really got the bit between his teeth this year and by winning the Nelly AND the Pathfinder he has virtually sewn up the National Championship - unless.....!! Still two events to go!

Janice Bell of Norfolk Sporting Club has taken the Winner's spot in the Minor and I am sure that the Course on Rally Navigation (worth £22-50) donated by one of the sponsors - Rally Navigation Services - will be put to good use! Husband, Dave, came 14th in this year's FULL but was the winner in 1990 - we could have some battle in '94!! All the remaining awards in the MINOR went to CSMA members and it is nice to record that the Best Lady award went to Miss Jenny Moulton - aged just 14! She was 3rd Lady last year so practice is definitely paying off!

Thanks to our Sponsors - Frizzell Financial Services Ltd., Britannia Rescue, Ordnance Survey and Rally Navigation Services - we have been able to give a very extensive and valuable awards list. When the first 18 out of 87 finishers in the FULL all received an award - which included £173 IN CASH - it just shows how valuable this support is!
