RESULTS

With an entry of 114 for the FULL, as against 126 last year, the trend of reduced entry for TT's has continued (no doubt brought about by the economic situation and the fact that 'spare time' is a very limited commodity). However, on the otherside of the coin, we had the highest percentage of returned answer sheets ever with nearly 81%! In the MINOR 74 out of the 81 entrants were from our own Club which shows the 'Pulling power' from our notice in the M&L - our House Magazine. Many of these must have wondered what they had let themselves in for when they got the route! We advertise the MINOR as a 'Learning course in Map Reading' and it is hoped that from the detail given in these results those of you who are still foxed will spare the time to work it all out. In many cases, once the penny has dropped, it all seems so easy?? If you are still suffering from nightmares about some particular type of route card after you have studied these results Andy is only too willing to help upon receipt of an SAE.

Colin Hensman - for the second consecutive year - is the overall winner in the FULL with a score of 8 penalty marks. Congratulations to him and the £50 prize will certainly get his Christmas off to a good start! He was a 2 points clear winner over the Runner-up - Roger Lintott (5th last year!). Malcolm Price, 8th last year, was third this time just pipping Martin Rea. Doug Heard, 27th last year, has climbed to 5th this year, Peter Blatchford, who was an 'Also ran' at 67th last year ended up 6th this time and Jeff Smith was 7th after a lowly 24th position in '93!! There is no doubt about it ---- practice and persistence does pay off! Anne Wilson (CSMA Unattached to Group) was, for the second consecutive year, Best Lady! There was an increase in support from CSMA members, unattached to Groups, (46 as against 42 last year) and, again, we have awarded engraved pens to the best three being:- Donald Bradbury, William Lynch & Peter Lear.

Helen Dove (CSMA Unattached to Group, a newcomer to the Nelly via last year's Cultivator) was the clear winder of the MINOR and it is noted that ALL the prizewinners were CSMA members! Whilst the Organisers must, of course, remain neutral it would be nice to see some transfer to the FULL and give some of the other Clubs a run for their money!! There were only 38 finishers (those that return the answer sheets) out of 81 entered which is a little disappointing to the Organisers - you will send in the answer sheet next year?? - but this is reflected in that over 31% of the finishers got an award!!

As usual, our thanks to the Sponsors - Frizzell Financial Services Ltd., Britannia Rescue (a wholly owned subsidiary company of CSMA to which some ¾ of the membership support!). Ordnance Survey and Rally Navigation Services for their continued support which enables us to give such an extensive and valuable awards list.
